- (i) Notification No. DMG/MAJ/MAP/SCHEME/01 dated 7th March, 2013 published in the Official Gazette (Extraordinary), Series I No. 49 dated 11th March, 2013 notifying the 'Umbrella Scheme' viz. "Mining Affected/Impacted Relief Scheme, 2013".
 - (ii) Notification No. DMG/MAJ/MAP/SCHEME/02 dated 7th March, 2013 published in the Official Gazette (Extraordinary), Series I No. 49 dated 11th March, 2013 notifying the "Scheme for providing financial relief to the truck (tipper) owners engaged in mining operations in mining affected areas".
 - (iii) Notification No. DMG/MAJ/MAP/SCHEME/03 dated 7th March, 2013 published in the Official Gazette (Extraordinary), Series I No. 49 dated 11th March, 2013

notifying the "Scheme to provide financial relief to the people residing in Mining Affected Areas, who have lost their employment due to closure of Mining Industry".

- (iv) Notification No. DMG/MAJ/MAP/SCHEME/1280 dated 25th July, 2013 published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 18 dated 1st August, 2013.
- (v) Notification No. DMG/MAJ/MAP/SCHEME/2607 dated 1st January, 2014 published in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 40 dated 2nd January, 2014.

In exercise of the powers conferred under clause (5) of the Umbrella Scheme [read at (i) above] empowering it so to do, the Government of Goa is pleased to amend the Schemes read at (i), (ii) and (iii) above, so as to remove certain difficulties arising out of the implementation of the scheme(s) viz:—

(i) Extension of clause 3 (f) of Notification read at (ii) above and further Notification read at (iv) above:

The scheme shall be extended till 30th September, 2014, or commencement of transportation of ore by tipper/truck subject to the following condition being fulfilled.

(1) The existing beneficiaries in order to avail the continuation of benefit from 1st January, 2014 shall be required to produce a certificate from concerned officer of Regional Transport Office stating that the tipper/truck stands in the name of the beneficiary as on date.

(2) The above certificate should be submitted to the Manager, Goa Electronics Ltd. along with an application for extension of benefit on plain paper stating the name of the beneficiary, his full residential address, tipper/truck Reg. No., GEL Reg. No. issued for trucks/tippers. The said application for extension shall be endorsed by a Member of Legislative Assembly or Member of Parliament or a Gazetted Officer of State Government not below the rank of Joint Secretary to the Government.

(3) The benefit shall not be given to tippers for that month where they have operated their tipper for transportation of ore for more than 10 trips in that month.

(ii) Extension of clause 1 (b) of Notification read at (iii) above. The scheme shall be further extended from 1st January, 2014 to 31st December, 2014.
